Program/Intervention: Organizational Perspective

- 1. My site is ready to support the implementation of [the intervention].
- 2. [*The intervention*] fits with the priorities at my site.
- There are no advantages to using [the intervention] compared to standard of care at my site. (reverse code)
- 4. [*The intervention*] is compatible with my workflow.
- 5. [The intervention] is user friendly.

Program/Intervention: Patient Perspective

- 6. The plan for [*the intervention*] implementation aligns with the needs and preferences of patients at my site.
- 7. [The intervention] will negatively impact care for patients at my site. (reverse code)
